Friends,

After a long January, I am looking forward to the shortest month of the year. I am hoping that we can get right through it and get on to Spring, but I am at least grateful that February is designed for easy planning. With the exception of leap years, February has four of each day, creating a tidy schedule and a smooth transition into March.

We don't find that kind of convenience elsewhere in the calendar. While months were initially set up to closely match cycles of the moon (which are roughly 29.5 days), the year matches the earth's revolution around the sun (almost 365.25 days). A day matches the earth's rotation on its axis. Seconds, minutes, and hours were set up so that the day could be divided evenly. While some of these measurements are irregular and don't match up with one another (hence the need for leap days), they were based on humankind's effort to create a rhythm out of the natural environment God gave us.

A week, on the other hand, was developed with some more direct divine assistance. While a number of ancient cultures used seven-day cycles in their calendars, we also know from the first chapter of the Bible that God set out a seven “day” pattern of His own. Later, in the commandments, God instructed us to set aside the seventh of those days much in the same way that He did.

So, while we have some of our own ways of measuring time—albeit imperfectly—we also practice a rhythm that God claimed and presented us in His commands to follow Him. We probably go from day to day and week to week without thinking much about that beyond gathering for worship on Sundays, but the truth is that having certain rhythms in our lives can be of great help in our efforts to grow closer to God.

During the month of February, I am going to focus on some of those rhythms and patterns using a handful of different Bible passages. I will also borrow some insights on worship and discipleship from a recent book called *You Are What You Love: The Spiritual Power of Habit* by Christian philosopher James K. A. Smith. Smith argues, as many authors have before him (including the Psalmists and others in Scripture), that God has instilled in us the need to worship and follow. Additionally, if we are not following the Spirit to worship Jesus, then we are at greater risk of pursuing other desires to worship false gods that we mistakenly think will save and redeem us.

Even though February is short, it is well suited for considering the rhythms that shape our lives. I hope that we can use this month to get our own rhythms more closely aligned with God's desires. I also pray that God will make those desires known to each of us, for our lives and for our life together. See you this month!

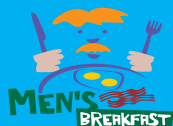

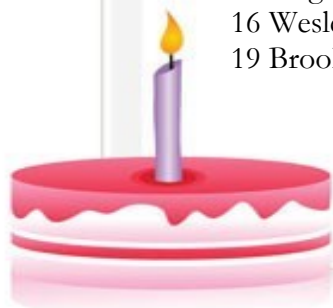
