Old Fashioned Bread Pudding
with Vanilla Sauce—by special request

Ingredients

Pudding

1 loaf (4 cups) French bread, cubed 1 1/2 inches
1/2 raisins—opt.
2 c. milk
1/4 c butter
1/2 c sugar
2 large eggs, slightly beaten
1 Tbsp vanilla extract
1/2 tsp nutmeg
1 tsp cinnamon

Sauce

1/2 c butter
1/2 c sugar
1/2 c heavy whipping cream
1 Tbsp vanilla extract



How to make

Heat oven to 350. Grease 1 1/2 qt. casserole, set aside.

Place bread cubes onto baking sheet. Bake 8—10 minutes or until toasted.

Combine toasted bread cubes and raisins in prepared casserole; set aside.

Combine milk and 1/4 C butter in pan. Cook over med. heat 4—7 min. or until butter is melted. Cool slightly.

Combine all remaining pudding ingredients in bowl; mix well. Add milk mixture; mix well.

Pour milk mixture over bread cubes. Bake 40-45 min. or until set in center.

Meanwhile, combine all sauce ingredients *except* vanilla in pan. Cook over med. Heat, stirring occasionally, 5—8 min. or until mixture thickens and comes to a full boil. Carefully stir in 1 Tbsp vanilla.

Spoon warm pudding into individual dessert dishes; serve with sauce. Store refrigerated.
