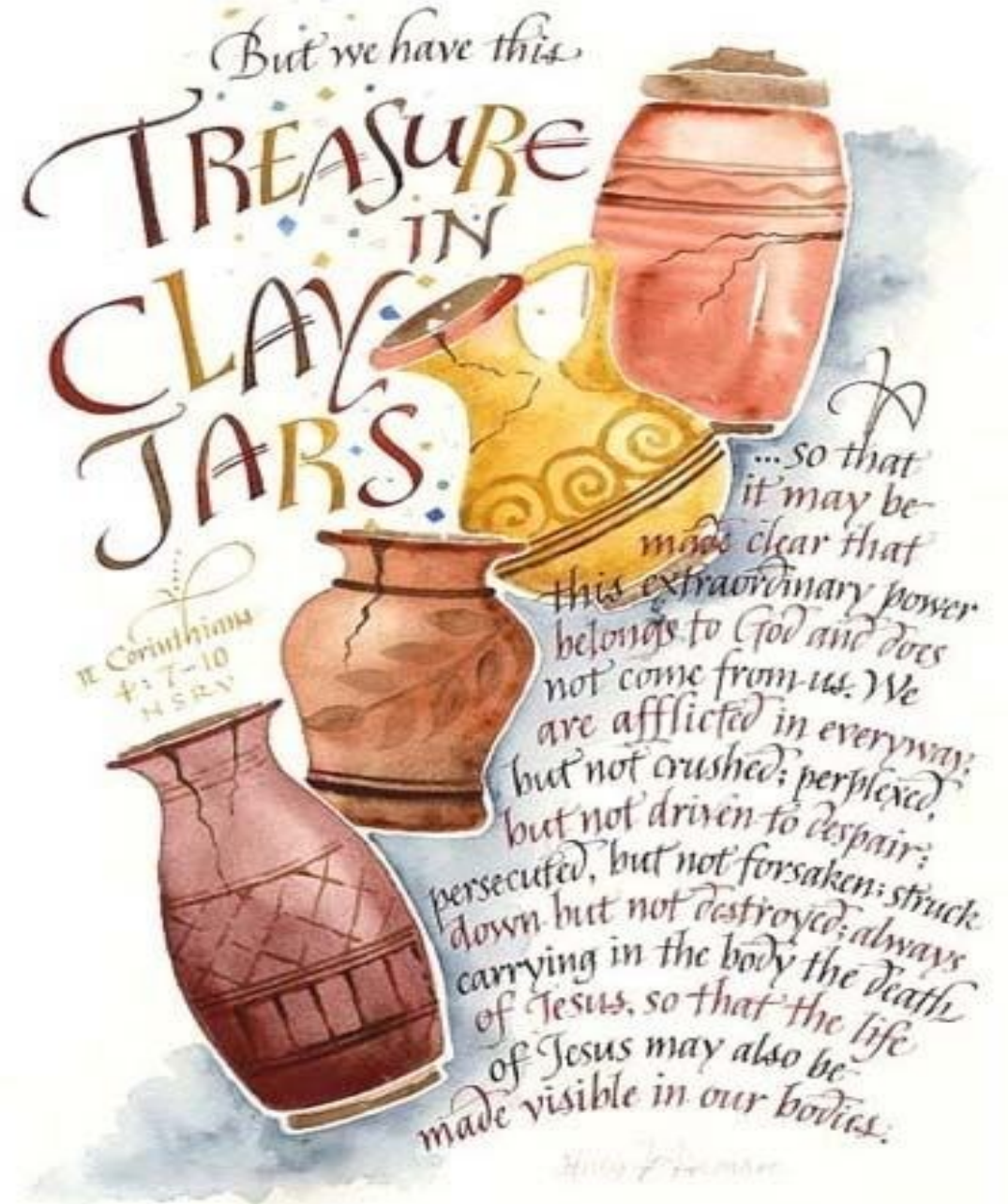
Benediction
