

Mission Focus: Endowing People

First Presbyterian Church is working this year with Rev. David Baker to sponsor Endowing People. Endowing People's mission is to provide a year's worth of guaranteed basic income and financial literacy training designed to lift families out of "working poor" status and into financial stability and security. Instruction includes budgeting, investing, home buying, insurance, and retirement planning among other things.

Rev. Baker started the class in 2023. The results were extremely encouraging, with many participants finding better jobs, starting retirement accounts, getting out of debt and saving money. Most of all, the people who participated now have hope for their financial futures and that of their families now that they understand finances and how to make money from their savings.

This year's class has ten individuals. They meet the third Wednesday of each month. The partnership with FPC is a trial for using a model like Endowing People for evangelism. Under the agreement, the church has agreed to provide support for the new class of Endowing People participants for member involvement, grant funds, and congregation contributions. The FPC Mission Committee is meeting with class members to greet Endowing People participants at meetings and invite them to participate in church activities and services. In addition, FPC was recently awarded a \$4,500 grant to support the program. We are now asking for your support.

Starting July 7, a one-page Commitment Form will be placed next to the bulletin. If you are interested in helping FPC support this program, please complete the form. You may attach a check made to First Presbyterian Church (Endowing People on memo line) and return it in the offering plate or the church office.

Through Endowing People, First Presbyterian Church is extending its ministry beyond its traditional boundary to the community, helping people secure financial sufficiency while learning about the church mission.
