About the Anthem:

This anthem was commissioned for the 200 th church anniversary of First Presbyterian Church of East Avon, New York. Their church motto, "Love grows here," is included in the lyrics. Alongside their motto, I found another brief statement of faith on the church's website, "We have faith that Christ is with us and that we can do all things through Him – even though we may have doubt." The historical marker in the town of East Avon mentions their church, "East Avon began to develop all the elements of a thriving community known for the Wiard Plow, White Horse Tavern, First Presbyterian Church, and suspected Underground Railroad activities."

This brought to mind the verse, "... do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, so that your giving will be in secret; and your Father who sees what is done in secret will reward you" (Matthew 6:3b-4, NASB95). I found East Avon's enduring faith very inspiring. Let us love our neighbors extravagantly without proof or recognition. Let it be 'suspected' in decades that we shared God's abundance and love.
