About the Anthem:

Part of the second stanza of this carol had not been translated into English. I translated it below:

O brilliant star that announces the dawn, May we never overlook your beneficent light. Glory in the highest to the Son of God, Glory in the highest and love on earth.

I first learned this carol in Spanish and the Ladino dialect while teaching it to my elementary choir students seven years ago. I discovered this Puerto Rican version in our library; it perfectly captures the brilliance of the star that the Three Kings followed on their long journey to meet Jesus Christ. It also points to Christ as the Light of the World, the Dawn of Hope for all people. The journey of the Magi on their camels was much longer than the twelve days we have enjoyed since Christmas – some historians estimate fifteen months or close to two years! I wish each of you light and love on Epiphany and throughout this new year. May the light of the candles in the sanctuary always remind us of the Light of Christ shining into the darkness of a weary world.
