

"There's a Sweet, Sweet Spirit" By Doris Mae Akers (1923-1995) There's a sweet, sweet Spirit in this place, And I know that it's the Spirit of the Lord. There are sweet expressions on each face, And I know they feel the presence of the Lord. Refrain: Sweet Holy Spirit, sweet heavenly Dove, Stay right here with us, filling us with Your love; And for these blessings we lift our hearts in praise; Without a doubt we'll know that we have been revived When we shall leave this place. There are blessings you cannot receive Till you know Him in His fullness and believe; You're the one to profit when you say, "I am going to walk with Jesus all the way." Refrain repeats.

About the Anthem:

Doris Akers was born to an interracial couple in rural Linn County, Missouri. She began playing the piano by ear at the age of six and wrote her first song at ten. As a teenager, she performed with several of her siblings in a gospel group "Dot and the Swingsters." In the 1940s, Doris moved to Los Angeles where she co-wrote music with Mahalia Jackson (ca. 1958) and directed the Sky Pilot Choir, an integrated gospel choir that appeared on radio and television broadcasts as well as weekly worship services. She went on to record albums under the RCA Victor label with her choir, their organist, and as a solo artist. She collaborated with "The Statesmen," most notably on "Highway to Heaven."

Ms. Akers moved to Columbus, Ohio in 1970. It was there she began writing, recording, and releasing about one album per year through regional Midwest record labels. In total, she released eight collections and had at least thirty-four hit songs. She toured with the Gaither group for the last several years of her life while serving as a minister of music in Minnesota. Doris Akers became known in the music industry as "Miss Gospel Music" because she mastered every aspect of creating gospel songs – vocals, keyboards, direction, arranging, composition, and publishing. In 1992, the Smithsonian Institution honored Doris Akers as "the foremost Black gospel songwriter in the United States." In addition to "There's a Sweet, Sweet Spirit," another song by Ms. Akers is included in Glory to God: The Presbyterian Hymnal – "Lead Me, Guide Me."
