
ANNOUNCEMENTS

LIGHTING OF THE CHRIST CANDLE

On this Christmas Eve we recall the hope we have in Christ. Tonight we light the candles of hope, peace, joy, and love. *First Candle*: We speak of hope because God keeps his promises to us.
